ST. JOSEPH'S HEALTH YEAR-IN-REVIEW

JUNE 2023: From Rural Louisiana to Paterson, New Jersey, Matthew Ostroff, Vascular Access Coordinator Performs Lifesaving Procedures

Matthew Ostroff, MSN, APN, VABC, Vascular Access Coordinator, recently learned about a cancer patient from Franklin Medical Center in Louisiana who was no longer able to receive chemotherapy via his upper chest vessels.



His only option was a femoral line placement tunneled to the abdominal wall, a technique only performed at the bedside by Ostroff. The patient was flown along with his wife and the Director of Nursing at Franklin Medical Center to St. Joseph's University Medical Center for this life saving procedure that not only allowed him to continue his cancer treatments, but also drastically improved his quality of life. Ostroff was also able to train the Director of Nursing to perform this procedure herself so she would be able to help other patients in her hospital and surrounding areas.

JULY 2023: Housing is Healthcare: Barclay Place Opens for Residents

St. Joseph's proudly joined with state, city, and community partners to open Barclay Place, the first hospital-based supportive housing in New Jersey. The five-story, modern apartment building has been completed under an innovative state partnership program that promotes

hospital investment in affordable and supportive housing in their communities. With 56 units, Barclay Place in Paterson is now available for vulnerable families and individuals to rent affordable apartments and access supportive services provided by St. Joseph's Health.



Studies have shown that secure and supportive housing can improve the quality of life and health of the community. This program is the first to be created, financed, and led by a state agency – with hospitals partnering to invest in housing that promotes and sustains health.

OCTOBER 2023: St. Joseph's Health Partners with US Department of Homeland Security on Human Trafficking Prevention

St. Joseph's Health hosted a press conference to announce a partnership with the US Department of Homeland



Security on the Blue Campaign, a national awareness and education initiative designed to prevent human trafficking and protect exploited persons. As a part of the Blue Campaign at St. Joseph's Health, Emergency Department staff members will receive training and implement protocols on detecting and preventing human trafficking, protecting victims, and prosecuting traffickers.

OCTOBER 2023: Introducing St. Joseph's New Antenatal Testing Unit



Open at last! Former President & CEO Kevin Slavin, along with our St. Joseph's family, joined Roger Kierce, MD, FACOG, Chairman of Obstetrics & Gynecology; Kaila Krishnamoorthy, MD, FACOG, Perinatologist; and David Principe, MD, FACOG, Perinatologist, to commemorate the official grand opening of St. Joseph's cutting-edge antenatal testing unit. After several months of construction, the expansion accommodates a wide variety of tools to evaluate the health of mother and baby, including obstetric ultrasounds and fetal testing. The modern unit includes six sonogram rooms and three fetal monitoring stations. We are opening doors to a new era of compassionate, high-quality care for mother and child.

MAY 2023: St. Joseph's and Hackensack Meridian Open The Cancer Center at Totowa

St. Joseph's Health and Hackensack Meridian Health have officially opened the Cancer Center at Totowa, located on our St. Joseph's Totowa Health Campus. In partnership with Hackensack Meridian's John Theurer Cancer Center, the new facility brings the very best



multidisciplinary, disease-specific teams of specialists, experts and medical practitioners to support our patients in every aspect of their cancer journey. The new center, spanning 70,000 square feet at 225 Minnisink Road in Totowa, is the marquee facility of our three enhanced cancer centers – a combined effort to bring comprehensive cancer care throughout the region. Services being offered at the Cancer Center at Totowa include genomic testing, immunotherapy, diagnostic services, infusion services, lab services, medical oncology, radiation therapy and targeted therapy, plus nutrition and counseling. This project was accomplished with the generous support of The Martini Family Foundation.

JUNE 2023: Honoring the memory of Dr. Rabbat: Newly Renovated Muslim Prayer Rooms

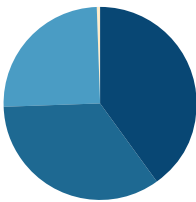

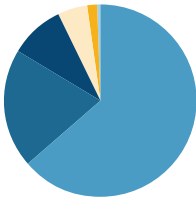
